

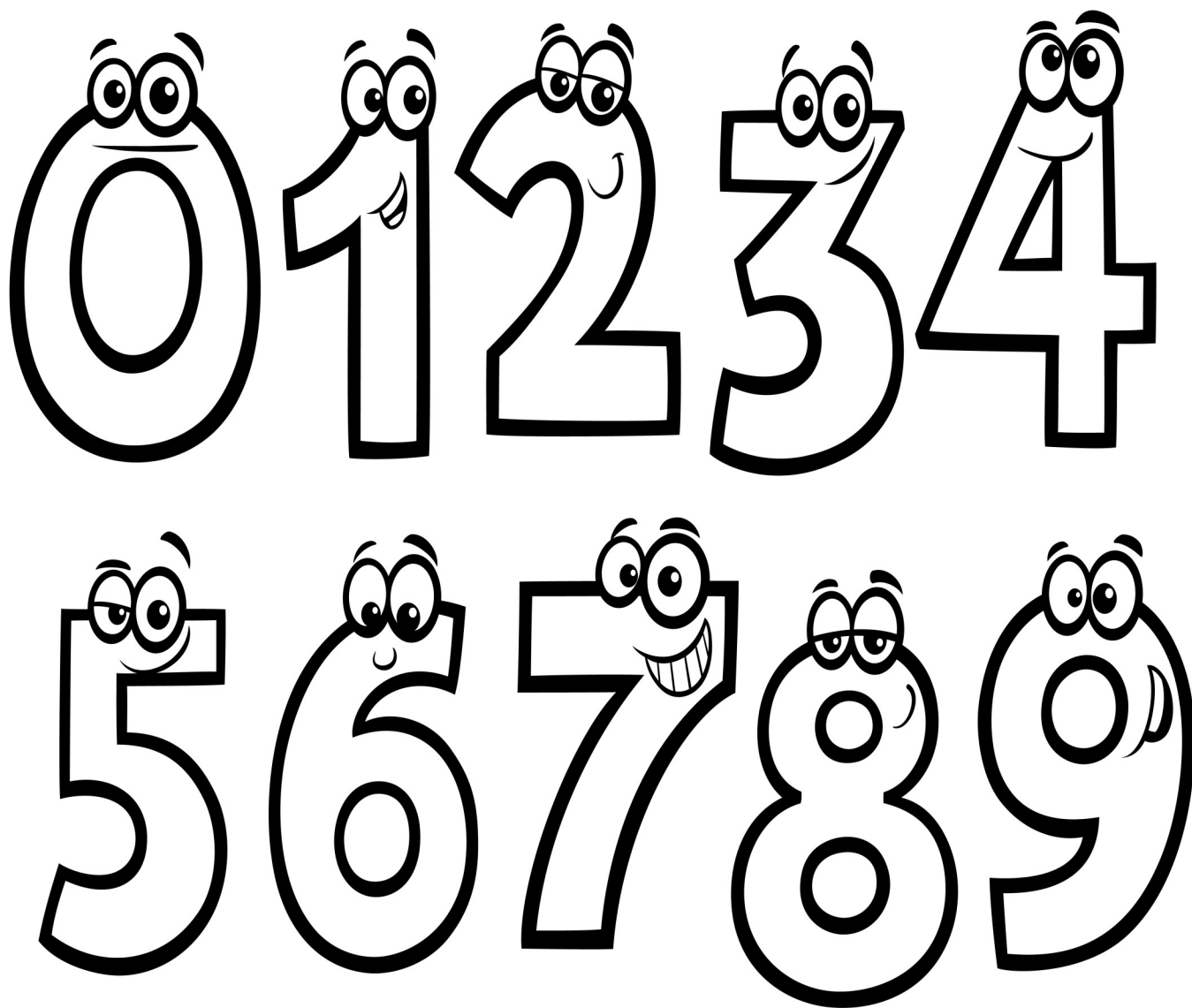


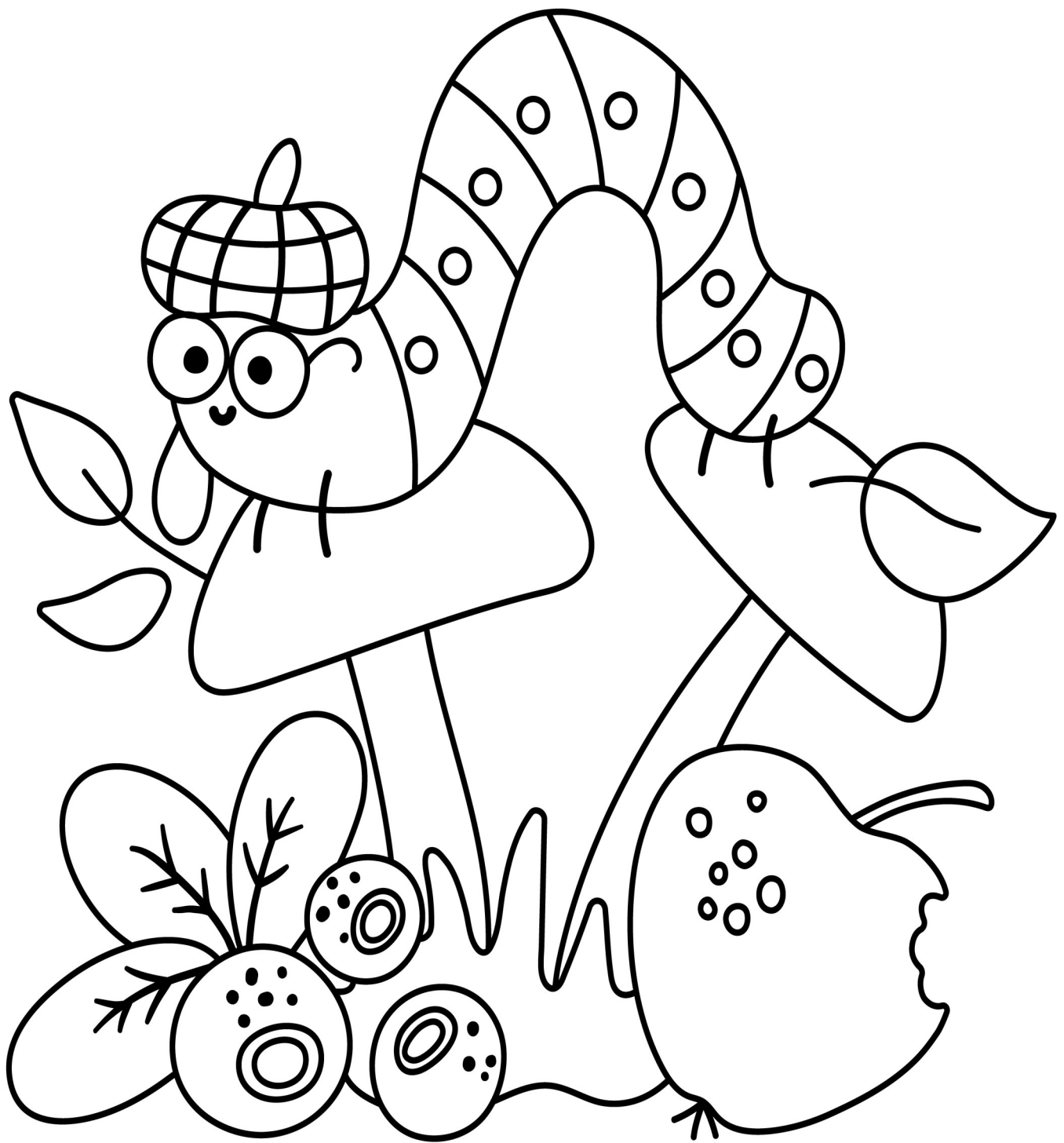
Baby Time

Alphabet Song

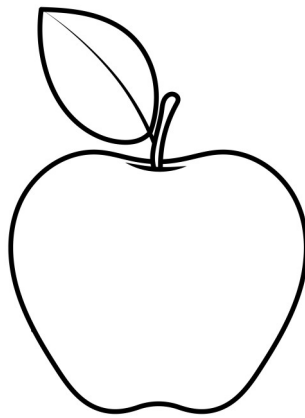
A-B-C-D-E-F-G—

M is for Moon

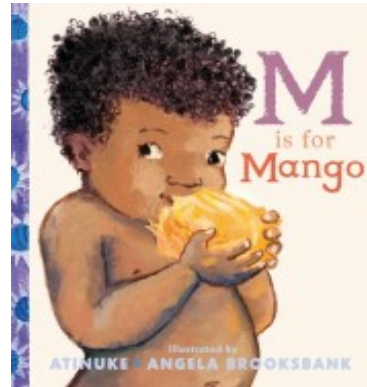
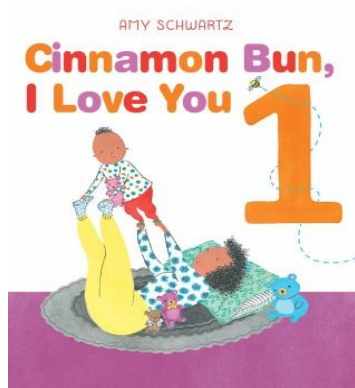
The moon is round,

And a mouth like me!



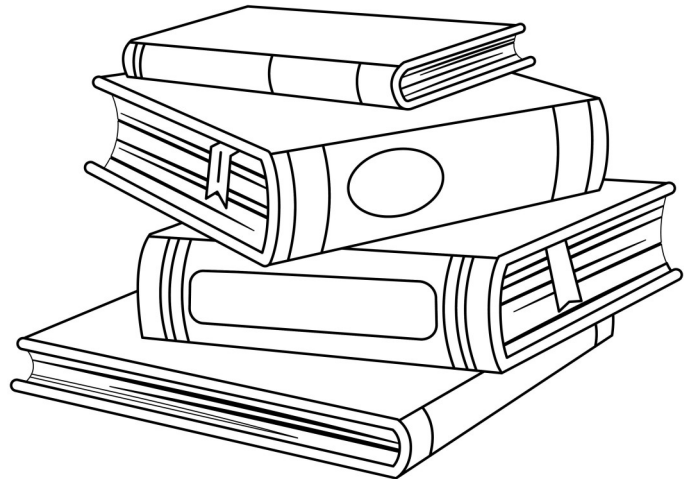
